Dear Resident:

In order to ensure the Tribe's safety in case of evacuation for any reason, plan to meet at:

Evacuation Location: **Redwood Empire Fairgrounds (UKIAH)**
1055 North State Street Ukiah, CA 95482

The Tribe will have vans available for those with no transportation. Van space is limited and should be saved for those who need it the most. **If you need a ride, remain outside of your home with your "go bag".**

In the event that we are unable to evacuate this direction due to the location of the fire, an alternative site will be identified and broadcast via:

- social media (facebook.com/cvtribalhealth)
- text (be sure to opt in to text messages from Coyote Valley by sending EZCOYOTE to 44777).

Willits Frontier Days Rodeo Grounds (WILLITS), East Commercial Street Willits, CA 95490

Mendocino County Fairgrounds (BOONVILLE), 14400 CA-128 Boonville, CA 95415

Robinson Rancheria Resort and Casino (UPPER LAKE), 1545 Hwy 20 Upper Lake, CA 95485

A "go-bag" packed ahead of time should include:

- ◇ Documents (copies of identification and insurance, photos and other important papers)
- ◇ Cash
- ◇ Medications List (list all prescriptions and other important medical cards)
- ◇ Flashlight and Batteries (packed separately)
- ◇ First Aid Kit
- ◇ Facial coverings and sanitizer
- ◇ Blankets (sleeping bags, pillows)
- ◇ Clothes for 2 days for each person (prepare for all weather)
- ◇ Phone Charger (extra)
- ◇ Non-Perishable Food & Water (plan 3 gallons per person)
- ◇ Trash bags
- ◇ Other? What do you use daily that you will need if you are not home? (Diapers, formula, pet food, pet supplies/carriers, children's toys)

Lastly, how will you leave when it is time? If you do not have adequate transportation who can you contact for help? Are family or neighbors near you in need of assistance that you can provide? Talk to them now to prepare. It will take each of us helping each other to relocate and stay safe.
